QUESTION OF: The Situation in North Korea

1. **Demands** that if any offensive is undertaken by the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK), regardless of the target and damage, all countries embargo all trade with DPRK;
2. **Guarantees** humanitarian aid to any country attacked in case of nuclear or conventional attack;
3. **Aids** the evacuation of South Koreans should an assault be made by the DPRK;
4. **Forces** diplomatic negotiation between the DPRK, South Korea and the United States of America (USA):
  - a) Asks the USA to retreat,
  - b) Asks the DPRK to retreat,
  - c) If sub-clauses a) and b) work, initiates peace discussions out of Korea with every other leaders to avoid any other conflict, and if the above fail and the DPRK attacks, requests military intervention;
5. **Urges** the DPRK to resume negotiations:
  - a) concerning its nuclear weapons programme and re-enter the six-party talks, and
  - b) emphasising the necessity to continue to implement the existing resolutions on the topic of the DPRK, which permanently commit to the dismantlement of their nuclear programme,
  - c) the UN shall decide on the sanctions should the DPRK not respect sub-clauses a) and b), which could range from military intervention to the exclusion of the DPRK from further conferences;

6. **Decides** to remain actively seized of the matter.
