QUESTION OF: Fungal diseases in crops

Reminds all member nations of the possibility of GMOs (Genetically Modified Crops), fertilizers and modern technology as a solution,

Noting with gravity the unpredictable pattern winds may carry such diseases in,

Knowing that 600 million tonnes of wheat is produced annually,

Realizes the global significance of the disease due to its' rapid spread and the financial aspects such as inflation, that may be seen,

1. Urges affected countries, who's climate would allow it, by black rust to cultivate wheat in green houses,

2. Proposes that financing funds will be:

- a) provided by the Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO) and the World Bank
- b) further provided from the countries affected by the Black Rust as a compensation to the new wheat producers
- c) sponsored by all countries;

3. Encourages the exponential growth and production of U99 resistant seeds by :

- a) funding research
 - i) production of lots of sub-species of crops in order to avoid similar situations
 - ii) Regular inspections made by the UN on all cereal crops to avoid loss of total production
- b) gradually replace normal wheat by U99 resistant wheat and other crops until enough U99 resistant crops are present to completely replace normal wheat :
 - i) the redistribution of U99 resistant wheat will be made by the UN, grants will be given to the major producers
 - ii) subsidies will be given to wheat producers to replace what has been lost;

4. Requests developing countries who aren't affected by disease to start self-production of wheat which would:

- a) would improve the self autonomy of the country
- b) increase the local economical development;
