QUESTION OF: Energy delivery in LEDCs.

- 1) Encourages LEDCs to allocate 10% of renewable energies by 2025, looking to increase that amount in the future with the support of MEDCs through research and the development of infrastructure,
- 2) Calls upon MEDCs and the UN to enforce their efforts in investing for the greater implementation of clean energy production sites in LEDCs, in order to develop a sustainable energy production system and to promote a greater independence from fossil fuels and nuclear energies,
- 3) Encourages all States to reinforce cooperation between MEDCs and LEDCs,
- 4) Strongly suggests member states develop nuclear energy programs including, but not limited to:
 - a. Sharing research of nuclear fusion (3 to 4 times more powerful than fission),
 - b. All sanctions shall be maintained on the use of nuclear materials, the UN is encouraged to demand transparency of the nuclear activities in the countries deemed 'untrustworthy' or 'hostile' towards other countries,
 - c. Encouraging research on the recycling of Uranium through the implementation of CANDU (the Canadian Agreement),
 - d. Starting a fund with 0.7% of GDP of nuclear-armed nations' defense budget towards nuclear safety research where fees are reduced in ratio to member states reduction of nuclear warheads.
